Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1 **Read Together**

Write the letters *Oo*, *Pp*, *Qq*, *Rr*, and *Ss* on index cards. Show a letter and have your child tell what letter it is. Then have your child look around your home to find words that have that letter. Continue with other letters.

Day 2 **Read Together**

Have your child read Decodable Story *Little Me!* Find words that begin with the letters *Oo*, *Pp*, *Qq*, *Rr*, or *Ss*. Also have children name the letters and pictures on page 4.

Day 3 **Counting Syllables**

Point to words in Decodable Story *Little Me!* After your child has read the story, say each word. Have your child clap the number of syllables in each word you say.

Day 4 **What We Look Like**

Help your child make a list of words that describe what he or she looks like. Include hair and eye colors and colors and kinds of clothing.

Day 5 **Practice Handwriting**

Have your child practice writing words for the letters *Oo* to *Ss*.
