We are ready to begin our second half of the school year! Here's a look at what we've been doing along with a couple of reminders.

#### Language Arts

In language arts we are now on Unit 4 in our language arts program, Reading Street. Our phonics skills with focus on words ending with -le, vowel patterns ou and u, diphthongs ou, ow, oi, oy, syllable patterns, and dipthongs oo, ue, ew, and ui. The comprehension skills we will focus on are drawing conclusions, sequencing, facts and opinions, and plot and theme. In grammar we will be focusing on adjectives and adverbs. Encourage your child to read at home at least 15 to 20 minutes a night. If you would like information on how to access any of our online language arts programs, please let me know and I will get you those instructions.

## Math

This month in math we are finishing up our unit focusing on addition and subtraction of numbers to 1,000. We will begin our unit on comparisons and addition and subtraction with length and money. # Science/Social Studies/Health

In social studies this month we are finishing up map skills. We have really enjoyed learning how to read different maps, learning about landforms, and learning about different countries and continents. Our science unit on Life Cycles will begin this month and continue into February. I have been looking forward to this unit and hatching chicks since I heard I was moving to second grade! We are going to have a lot of fun with this unit!
